HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 981,
L. D. 1265, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Membership on the Board of
School Directors."

Amend said Amendment by striking out everything except the
last paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Amend said Bill in section 1 by adding after the underlined
word "spouse" in the 4th line (same in L. D.) the underlined
punctuation and words ',brother, sister, son or daughter'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 (same
in L. D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 20, §472, amended. The 4th sentence
of section 472 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended,
is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

No member of the school committee of any such town or spouse,
brother, sister, son or daughter shall be employed as a teacher
or as any other employee in any public school in said town or
contract high school or academy located within a supervisory
union of which he is a member of the joint committee.'
