HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 981, L.D. 1265, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Membership on the Board of School Directors."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting
in place thereof the following title: 'AN ACT Regarding the
Membership of School Committees and Boards of School Directors.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 20, §302, amended. The next to the last
paragraph of section 302 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as
amended, is further amended to read as follows:

No member of the board of school directors or spouse shall be
employed as a full-time teacher or-in-any-other-capacity in any
public school that comes within the jurisdiction of the board of
directors of which he is a member.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 20, §472, amended. The 4th sentence of
section 472 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is
repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

No member of the school committee of any such town or spouse shall
be employed as a full-time teacher in any public school in said
town or contract high school or academy located within a supervisory
union of which he is a member of the joint committee.

Sec. 3. Application. This Act shall only apply to those
persons who are elected as members of school committees or
boards of school directors after January 1, 1970.'
