**AN ACT Providing Increased Reimbursement for High School Diploma
Programs in Maine's General Adult Evening Schools.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 2404, amended. The first sentence of section 2404 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 19 of chapter 425 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

Whenever the school committee or school directors of any administrative unit shall have maintained during the school year evening schools, day schools, classes and educational activities for adults as provided by section 858, said administrative unit shall be reimbursed by the State a sum equal to $\frac{1}{2}$ the amount paid for instruction and activities contributing to learning in such classes, except that said administrative unit shall be reimbursed by the State a sum equal to 75% of the amount paid for instruction for credit courses leading toward a high school diploma, but the cost of instruction will be at rates not exceeding rates for other adult classes.
