## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Election of Trustees of Maine Central Institute.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1866, c. 17, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 17 of the private and special laws of 1866, as last repealed and replaced by chapter 25 of the private and special laws of 1943, is amended by adding 2 new paragraphs, to read as follows:

The alumni association of the institute may adopt rules and bylaws for the management of its affairs and its funds, which shall be kept separate from those of the institute, may establish its own office and may elect all necessary officers. The trustees are directed to furnish alumni lists and records, or copies thereof, to the alumni association upon request.

Beginning at the time of the annual meeting of the board of trustees in the year 1970 and thereafter, successor trustees for those whose terms expire shall be elected by the alumni association of the institute in such manner and with such conditions of eligibility as the said association may determine, and said association shall have the right to fill vacancies for unexpired terms. Nothing in this paragraph shall be construed to abridge the terms of any alumni trustees now in office.
