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**AN ACT** Revising the Boundaries of the Northern and  
Southern Hunting Zones.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2353, amended. The 2nd and 3rd paragraphs of section 2353 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as last repealed and replaced by chapter 500 of the public laws of 1967, are repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

**Northern Zone:** North of the Appalachian Trail starting at the Maine - New Hampshire border to Route #6, then along Route #6 to the Canadian Pacific Railway tracks, along said tracks to Mattawamkeag, then easterly along the Maine Central Railway tracks to Vanceboro.

**Southern Zone:** South of the Appalachian Trail starting at the Maine - New Hampshire border to Route #6, then along Route #6 to the Canadian Pacific Railway tracks, along said tracks to Mattawamkeag, then easterly along the Maine Central Railway tracks to Vanceboro.
