COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 375, L. D. 1285, Bill, "AN ACT Providing for Area Directional Signs on Maine Turnpike for Washington County Area."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the words "Washington County Area" and inserting in place thereof the words 'Hancock and Washington County areas'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1, R. S., T. 23, §1201, sub-§15, amended. Subsection 15 of section 1201 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

15. Hancock & Washington County Coastal Areas, including Bar Harbor and Passamaquoddy Eastport;

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 23, §1201, sub-§17, amended. Subsection 17 of section 1201 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

17. Washington County: Such sign shall be constructed and maintained on the Maine Turnpike no more than 10 miles southerly from the Augusta exit and shall be worded as follows:

Quoddy State Park - Most Easterly Point in the U. S. --Washington County - Exit 15; '
