**AN ACT Providing for Area Directional Signs on Maine Turnpike for
Washington County Area.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 1201, sub-§ 17, amended. Subsection 17 of section 1201 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

17. Washington County: Such signs shall be constructed and maintained on the Maine Turnpike no more than 10 miles southerly from the Augusta exit and shall be worded as follows:

Most Easterly ~~Point~~ Land in the U. S. — Washington County — **Take Route 3 at Augusta Exit 45;**
