IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Time of Filing Security Interests Under Commercial Code.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 11, § 9-301, sub-§ (2), amended. Subsection (2) of section 9-301 of Title 11 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- (2) If the secured party files with respect to a purchase money security interest before or within 10 20 days after the collateral comes into possession of the debtor, he takes priority over the rights of a transferee in bulk or of a lien creditor which arise between the time the security interest attaches and the time of filing.
