AN ACT Relating to Qualifications for Appointment as Commissioner of
Inland Fisheries and Game.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 1951, amended. The first sentence of section 1951 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

A Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game, as heretofore appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council and in chapters 301 to 335 called the "commissioner," **shall have professional training in the field of wildlife management** and shall hold office for 3 years and shall serve until his successor is appointed and qualified.
