STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Exception to Plumbers Law Because of Municipal Requirements.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 3302, amended. Section 3302 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

§ 3302. Exceptions

This chapter shall not apply to regular employees of public utilities as defined in Title 35, section 15, when working as such, nor to regular employees of owners or lessees of real property when working as such, nor to any oil burner man duly licensed under chapter 33, insofar as work covered by said license is involved, nor to persons whose occupation is the doing of miscellaneous jobs of manual labor in the course of which some incidental plumbing repairs or alterations are made by them, unless the city or town shall by ordinance or by law impose such licensing restrictions or requirements as a condition precedent to the issuance of a permit for the purpose of installing plumbing or drainage.
