### AN ACT Relating to Services of Private Clubs under Liquor Laws.

---

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 28, § 807, additional.** Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 807 to read as follows:

§ 807. —Certain services forbidden

It shall be unlawful for the officers or employers of private clubs, not licensed for the sale of liquor, to provide any services for the storage or handling of liquor which is the property of a club member or his guest, or to make any charges for bar services or for beverages or mixes when said club member or guest intends to consume the same with their liquor on the club premises.
