SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to S.P. 391, L.D. 1316, RESOLVE, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Permit Insurance of Payments on Mortgage Loans Made for Service Enterprises and for Preservation of Certain Business Enterprises.

Amend said Resolve by adding at the end of that part designated "Section 14-A" (same in L.D.) the following underlined sentence:
'For the purposes of this section such insurance in excess of \$5,000,000 shall be approved by the Governor and Council.'
