## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 104th LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "E" to S.P. 391, L.D. 1316, Resolve, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Permit Insurance of Payments on Mortgage Loans Made for Service Enterprises and for Preservation of Certain Business Enterprises.

Amend said Resolve in the Title by striking out the words "and for Preservation of Certain Business Enterprises"

Further amend said Resolve by striking out all of that part designated "Section 14-A" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Section 14-A. Permits insuring payment of industrial loans secured by real estate and personal property by legislative Act. For the purposes of fostering, encouraging and assisting the physical location, settlement and resettlement of industrial, manufacturing, fishing and , agricultural and service enterprises within the State, the Legislature by proper enactment may insure the payment of mortgage loans on the real estate and personal property within the State of such industrial, manufacturing, fishing and, agricultural and service enterprises not exceeding in the aggregate \$80,000,000 in amount at any one time and may also appropriate moneys and authorize the issuance of bonds on behalf of the State at such times and in such amounts as it may determine to make payments insured as aforesaid. Fer-the-purposes-ef-this-seetien,-a-decumented fishing-vessel-shall-be-eenstrued-as-real-estate.'

Further amend said Resolve in the Form of Question by striking out all of the question and inserting in place thereof the following:

' "Shall the Constitution be amended as proposed by a resolution of the Legislature Permitting Insurance of Payments on Mortgage Loans Made for Service Enterprises?" '
