STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Accrued Sick Leave of State Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Accumulated sick leave.

- 1. Death. On the death of a state employee cash payment shall be made for all accumulated sick leave up to 90 days.
- 2. Retirement. At time of retirement all state employees shall be paid for all accrued sick leave up to 90 days.
- 3. After 10 years of service. Any state employee who leaves state service after 10 years of creditable service shall be paid for $\frac{1}{2}$ of all accrued sick leave which shall not exceed 45 days.
- 4. Prior to 10 years of service. Any state employee who leaves state service prior to 10 years creditable service shall be paid for ½ of all accrued sick leave which shall not exceed 23 days.
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$150,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1970 and \$150,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1971 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
