**AN ACT** Providing for a Statutory Agent for Foreign Domiciled Carriers  
Purchasing Six-year Trailer Plates.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 29, § 245-A, amended.** Section 245-A of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 448 of the public laws of 1967, is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

The Secretary of State shall require the appointment of a true and lawful agent or representative for each and every foreign domiciled carrier. The said agent or representative shall be a Maine citizen and shall sign the registration certificate. Legal process served upon a carrier's designated agent or representative shall be deemed to be service upon the carrier. This applies only to foreign domiciled individuals, partnerships or corporations applying for 6-year semi-trailer plates.
