SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1030,
L.D. 1339, Bill, "AN ACT Providing for Implied Consent Law for
Operators of Motor Vehicles."

Amend said Amendment by striking out the last underlined
sentence of that part designated "8. Liability" and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'No person administering and conducting chemical tests of blood
or urine shall be held liable in damages or otherwise for any
act reasonably done or omitted to be done in administering or
conducting said test at the request of a law enforcement officer
pursuant to this section.'
