SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1087, L.D. 1341, Bill, "AN ACT Providing for Transportation of Passengers in Units of Trucking Equipment on a Test Basis."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the next to the last underlined sentence of the first paragraph of that part designated "§1505." of section 1 (same in L.D. 1341) in inserting in place thereof the following underlined sentence:

'If service is presently available between 2 points by reason of an existing certificate or certificates of public convenience and necessity, no trial certificate shall authorize operations between those points.'
