AN ACT Relating to Mediation Authority of State Employees Appeal Board.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 752, amended. The first sentence of section 752 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 539 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:

The board shall have the authority to mediate the final settlement of all grievances and disputes between individual state employees, both classified and unclassified, **Including employees of the Maine Turnpike Authority**, and their respective state agencies, except in matters of classification and compensation.
