COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 397, L.D. 1349, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Discrimination on Account of Race or Religion."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the next to the last underlined paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'It shall be the duty of the several county attorneys to investigate and prosecute complaints of violations of this section, and to institute proceedings before the Administrative Hearing Commissioner who shall be empowered to proceed under Title 5, chapters 301 to 307.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the last 2 lines (same in L.D.) the underlined words "with appropriate appeal to the Superior Court" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'with the right of appeal to the Superior Court under Title 5, chapter 307'
