STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Time for Teachers and Pupils for School Lunch.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 20, § 1056, additional. Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1056, to read as follows:

§ 1056. Time for school lunch

The superintending school committee or school directors of any school administrative unit shall allocate a minimum of $\frac{1}{2}$ hour each day to pupils and teachers for lunch.
