COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 399, L.D. 1353, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Adoptions."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting
clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 19, §531, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 531 of
Title 19 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter
432 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:
The court shall be deemed to have jurisdiction hereunder if such
person seeking the adoption shall have been continuously within the
State or a United States military reservation herein for a period
of at least 3 months prior to the date of the petition.'
