HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to S. P. 403, L. D. 1355, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Agricultural Roads."

Amend said Bill, in the Title, by striking out the words "Agricultural Roads" and inserting in place thereof the words 'Limited-User Highways' Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following: 'Where any public highway, road, street, town or county way, but not including roads or ways under the jurisdiction of the State Highway Commission, shall, after public notice, be found by the municipal officers-of-cities-and-towns governing body of a municipality, acting through the city council or board of aldermen in the case of a city, or through the process of a duly organized town meeting, with regard to such ways located within their respective boundaries, in organized territory, and the county commissioners in the case of such ways, located within their jurisdiction, in unorganized territory, to be of limited use and value to the traveling public, said city, town or county shall not be required to expend any further public funds on such ways, but such ways shall be deemed public ways, and not abandoned and the general public shall have the right to use same, and any person, firm, corporation or association may expend their funds for the upkeep of same on a purely voluntary basis.
