AN ACT Relating to Agricultural Roads.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 2068, amended. The first sentence of section 2068 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 240 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:

Where any public highway, road, street, town or county way, but not including roads or ways under the jurisdiction of the State Highway Commission and roads or ways in use for agricultural purposes, shall, after public notice, be found by the municipal officers of cities and towns with regard to such ways located within their respective boundaries, in organized territory, and the county commissioners in the case of such ways, located within their jurisdiction, in unorganized territory, to be of limited use and value to the traveling public, said city, town or county shall not be required to expend any further public funds on such ways, but such ways shall be deemed public ways, and not abandoned and the general public shall have the right to use same, and any person, firm, corporation or association may expend their funds for the upkeep of same on a purely voluntary basis.
