SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 383, L.D. 1356, Bill, "AN ACT Abolishing the Maine Aeronautics Commission, Transferring Certain of its Powers to an Aeronautical Director, Providing for the Tenure and Conpensation of Such Director and Relating to the Aeronautical Fund."

Amend said Amendment by inserting before the first paragraph the following:

'Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

Sec. 1. R.S., T. 6, §2, sub-§2 repealed. Subsection 2 of section 2 of Title 6 of the Revised Statutes is repealed.'

Further amend said Amendment, in the 9th paragraph, by adding at the end of that part designated paragraph E, before the semicolon, the following underlined words and punctuation: '<u>,except planes owned or operated by the Department of Inland</u> <u>Fisheries and Game, the Department of Sea and Shore Fisheries</u> and the Forestry Department'
