COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1055, L. D. 1387, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Compensation of Councilmen of City of Biddeford
and Prohibiting Contracts of Councilmen and Mayor With the City."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last 3 underlined
sentences of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following
underlined sentences:

'The councilmen shall receive a salary of \$10 per meeting attended,
up to a maximum of \$500 per year, for their services as such.'

The councilmen who shall be members of the finance committee shall
receive such compensation as the council may determine. Neither
the mayor nor any councilman shall directly or indirectly enter
into any contract with the city, except as provided by the Revised
Statutes, Title 30, section 2251.'
