STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Providing for a Feasibility Study for a High Level Bridge or Vehicular Underwater Tunnel Across Fore River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Study. The State Highway Commission is authorized and directed to study the feasibility and cost of a high level highway bridge or a vehicular underwater tunnel across the Fore River between the Cities of Portland and South Portland, in the County of Cumberland, to replace or supplement the existing state highway bridge between said cities, referred to as the Portland Bridge.
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the State Highway Commission, the sum of \$80,000 to carry out the purpose of this Act. Any unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this Act have been accomplished.
