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AN ACT Relating to Conferring Degrees by Husson College.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Degrees.** In addition to the rights and privileges and powers granted to Husson College by chapter 11 of the private and special laws of 1953, as amended by the private and special laws of 1963, chapter 15 and by the private and special laws of 1965, chapter 121, Husson College, a nonprofit corporation, of Bangor, Maine, is authorized by appropriate action of its trustees to confer upon distinguished persons in recognition of their achievements, fine works and contributions to society and mankind appropriate honorary doctorate degrees.
