COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1065, L.D. 1394, Bill, "AN ACT to Create a School Administrative District in the Town of Sanford."

Amend said Bill by striking out the last three sentences of the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following: 'Said district shall be managed pursuant to the Revised Statutes of 1964, Title 20, by a board of school directors consisting of 5 persons to be elected by the residents of the town at a meeting for the purpose. The board of school directors shall be elected, subject to the acceptance of this Act, by a plurality vote of the legal voters of the town, voting on 2 for a one-year term, 2 for a 2-year term and one for a 3-year term. At the expiration of each term, the vacancy or vacancies shall be filled for 3-year terms.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end of the 2nd paragraph the following sentence: 'For the purposes of this Act, the town is authorized to utilize the secret ballot procedure for the purpose of voting on said question.'
