STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Harness and Running Horse Races on Sunday.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 8, § 268, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 268 of Title 8 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, harness horse races or meets held on Sunday shall not commence until the hour of 1 p.m.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 8, § 326, amended. The last sentence of section 326 of Title 8 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, running horse races or meets held on Sunday shall not commence until the hour of r p.m.
