STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 104th LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1090, L. D. 1407, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Restrictions on Ice Fishing on all Inland Waters."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, §2553, amended. The last sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 2553 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 192 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

This paragraph shall not apply to Sebago Lake, Cumberland County. except waters open to ice fishing.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 12, §2553, amended. Section 2553 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding after the 4th paragraph, a new paragraph, to read as follows:

In waters open to ice fishing no person shall take, catch or kill in any one day or have in possession at any time more than 5 pounds in the aggregate of the trout, salmon, togue and black bass species unless the last fish caught increases the combined weight to more than 5 pounds.

Sec. 3. R. S., T. 12, §2651, amended. The 2nd sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 2651 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

All lines set for cusk in the nighttime must be visited at lease <u>least</u> once in every hour by the person setting the same.'
