HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1090, L. D. 1407, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Restrictions on Ice Fishing on all Inland Waters."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting
clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, §2651, amended. The last sentence of the
first paragraph of section 2651 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes
is amended to read as follows:

A person legally licensed may fish through the ice in the daytime with
not more than 5 3 lines, set or otherwise, which shall be under the
immediate supervision of such person, in any waters which have been
opened to ice fishing by the commissioner.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 12, §2651, amended. The 2nd paragraph of
section 2651 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by
section 26 of chapter 448 of the public laws of 1965, is further
amended to read as follows:

It shall be lawful to fish in the nighttime by using not more than
5 3 lines set or otherwise for cusk in the waters which have been
opened to ice fishing by the commissioner. All lines set for cusk
in the nighttime must be visited at ~~least~~ least once in every hour by
the person setting the same. The commissioner may open other waters
for fishing for cusk in the nighttime.'
