IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT to Designate an Official Mineral for the State of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 1, § 213, additional. Title 1 of the Revised Statutes is amended
by adding a new section 213 to read as follows:

§ 213. Official mineral

Tourmaline shall be designated as the official mineral for the State of Maine.
