COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1093, L.D. 1410, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Taking of Alewives in Georges River."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the underlined paragraph before the "Emergency clause" and inserting in place thereof the following underlined paragraph:

'Between April 20th and June 15th of each year no one shall fish, disturb or molest the alewives, or operate any boat within 1,000 feet of the alewife trap, located approximately 500 feet south of the Lower Warren Village Bridge on the Georges River.'
