IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Boilers and Unfired Steam Pressure Vessels.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 212, amended. Section 212 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

§ 212. Welding on boilers; certificates for welders

No ~~journeyman~~ welder performing welding work for hire shall make welding repairs to any steam vessel which carries a steam pressure of more than 15 pounds per square inch without first receiving authorization to do so from the Chief ~~Boiler Inspector~~ **Inspector of Boilers**. This provision shall not apply to persons who hold certificates or standing authorization from the Board of Boiler Rules.

The Board of Boiler Rules is authorized to make, amend or rescind reasonable rules and regulations relating to qualifications of ~~journeyman~~ welders for compensation and is further empowered to conduct examinations, issue certificates and to charge a reasonable fee for such examinations and for such certificates.

Any person violating this section may be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.
