HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1104, L.D. 1422, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Incurrigibles at Juvenile Training Centers."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by inserting in the next to  
last line (same in L.D.), after the underlined word "court" and  
before the comma, the underlined words 'which ordered commitment  
to the correctional center'

Further amend said Bill by adding before the "Emergency clause"  
the following new section:

'Sec. 16. Affect on existing commitments. The repeal of  
Title 15, section 2611, subsection 4, paragraph A, by section 1  
of this Act shall not terminate or affect in any other way any  
commitment made thereunder in effect upon the effective date of  
this Act. Parole as to any male inmate committed under such  
repealed section may be granted in accordance with Title 34,  
section 1673 as it applied to any such commitment at the time  
of its amendment by section 15 of this Act. Parole of any female  
committed under such repealed section may be in accordance with  
Title 34, section 1674.'
