STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Increasing Compensation of Councillors of Town of Mechanic Falls.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1945, c. 67, § 6, amended. Section 6 of chapter 67 of the private and special laws of 1945 is amended to read ε s follows:

Sec. 6. Compensation. Each councillor shall receive an annual salary of $\$_{50}$ $\$_{300}$. In addition to said annual salary, the councillors when sitting as a board of registration of voters in their capacity as municipal officers as required by law during the 3 secular days next preceding any primary election, state or presidential election, shall receive a per diem of $\$_3$ $\$_{15}$ each, meaning and intending that said board of registration shall constitute a legal board to pass upon the qualifications of persons desiring their names entered upon the polling list of said Town of Mechanic Falls. Provided further, that for such services as required under the general law, of such board of registration, acting in their capacity as municipal officers, at any such primary election, state or presidential election the per diem shall be $\$_5$ $\$_{20}$ per day. Payment for all services contemplated by this section shall be made by the town treasurer.
