COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 428, L. D. 1427, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Bids for Construction of State Highways."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the  
following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, §1746, amended. The first sentence of  
the 2nd paragraph of section 1746 of Title 5 of the Revised Sta-  
tutes, as enacted by chapter 437 of the public laws of 1967, is  
amended to read as follows:

Under any contract made or awarded by the State or by any public  
department or official thereof, including the construction, improve-  
ment or repair of any and all ways, roads or bridges with appurten-  
ances which, by law, are under the supervision of the State Highway  
Commission, the contractor may, from time to time, withdraw the  
whole or any portion of the amount retained for payments to the con-  
tractor pursuant to the terms of the contract, upon depositing with  
the Treasurer of State: A negotiable certificate of deposit, United  
States treasury bonds, United States treasury notes, United States  
treasury certificates of indebtedness, United States treasury bills,  
or bonds or notes of the State of Maine or bonds of any political  
subdivision in the State of Maine.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the  
first line after the enacting clause the abbreviation and figure

'Sec. 2.'
