AN ACT Relating to Bids for Construction of State Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 23, § 753, amended. The 4th sentence of section 753 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows :

Each bidder must accompany his bid with an official bank check, a cashier's check, a certified check, a certificate of deposit or a United States postal money order, payable to the Treasurer of State for an amount which the commission considers sufficient to guarantee that if the work is awarded to him he will contract with the commission for its due execution.
