HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1115, L.D. 1434, Bill, "An Act Relating to Chiropractic Services for Injured Employee Under Workmen's Compensation Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first underlined paragraph (Same in L.D. 1434) and inserting in place thereof the following underlined paragraph:

'An employes sustaining a personal injury by accident arising out of and in the course of his employment or who is disabled by occupational disease shall be entitled to reasonable and proper medical; surgical and hospital services, nursing, medicines, and such employee, should be voluntarily so choose, shall be entitled to chiropractic services, as needed, and mechanical and surgical side, as needed, paid for by his employer. An injured employee shall have the right to make his own selection of a physician or surgeon or chiropractor authorized to practice as such under the laws of this State from a panel or panels of physicians, surgeons and chiropractors selected by the Industrial Accident Commission for the services set forth.
