# STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

## AN ACT Relating to Sick Leave Under Lewiston City Charter.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. X, § 5, additional. Article X of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is amended by adding a new section 5, to read as follows:
- Sec. 5. Sick leave. Employees of the department of public works shall be allowed to accumulate one day of sick leave per month, a total of 12 days per year, accumulating to 120 days.

Upon retirement pursuant to the Maine State Employees Retirement System or city pension plan, an employee shall receive compensation at his rate of pay at the time of retirement for  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the number of days of his unused sick leave. This clause will be retroactive to January 1, 1969.

- Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 16-A, additional. Article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is amended by adding a new section 16-A, to read as follows:
- Sec. 16-A. Sick leave. Members of the police department shall be allowed to accumulate one day of sick leave per month, a total of 12 days per year, accumulating to 120 days.

Upon retirement pursuant to the Maine State Employees Retirement System or city pension plan, an employee shall receive compensation at his rate of pay at the time of retirement for  $\frac{1}{2}$  that number of days of his unused sick leave. This clause will be retroactive to January 1, 1969.

- Sec. 3. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XII, § 3-A, additional. Article XII of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is amended by adding a new section 3-A, to read as follows:
- Sec. 3-A. Sick leave. Members of the fire department shall be allowed to accumulate 1½ days of sick leave per month, a total of 18 days per year, accumulating to 120 days.

Upon retirement pursuant to the Maine State Employees Retirement System or city pension plan, an employee shall receive compensation at his rate of pay at the time of retirement for  $\frac{1}{2}$  the number of days of his unused sick leave. This clause will be retroactive to January 1, 1969.
