HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H. P. 1117, L. D. 1436, Bill,
"AN ACT Providing for the Observance of Certain Legal
Holidays on Monday."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out in the
7th line (same in L.D.) the stricken out words and figure
"~~the 19th day of April;~~" and inserting in place thereof
the words and figure 'the 19th day of April;' ; and by
striking out in the 7th and 8th lines (same in L.D.) the
underlined words and figure "Patriot's Day, the 3rd Monday
in April"

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in the
9th and 10th lines (7th and 8th lines in L.D.) the stricken
out words and figure and the underlined words and figure
"~~the 19th day of April~~ Patriot's Day, the 3rd Monday in April"
and inserting in place thereof the words and figure 'the 19th
day of April'

Further amend said Bill in section 4 by striking out in
the 4th line (same in L.D.) the stricken out word and figure
"~~April 19th~~" and the underlined words and figure "the 3rd Monday
in April" and inserting in place thereof the word and figure
'April 19th'

Further amend said Bill in section 6 by striking out in the 4th and 5th lines (same in L.D.) the stricken out words and figure "~~the-19th-day-of-April~~" and inserting in place thereof the words and figure 'the 19th day of April'; and by striking out in the 5th line (same in L.D.) the underlined words and figure "Patriot's Day, the 3rd Monday in April"
