SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1119, L.D. 1439, Bill, "AN ACT Permitting the Establishment of an Indian Township Passamaquoddy School Committee."

Amend said Bill, in the 6th line (5th line of L.D.), by inserting after the underlined words "school committee" the underlined words 'of not more than 5 members'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 1 the following underlined paragraphs:

'The Commissioner of Education shall appoint a superintendent of schools who shall serve in this office in the same legal capacity as any other public school superintendent.'

All bills must be approved for payment by the school committee members and the superintendent of schools, and a copy of each payroll filed with the commissioner.'

The biennial budget will be drawn up by the superintendent and school committee and forwarded to the Commissioner of Education for his consideration and recommendation before being submitted to the Legislature. The execution of the budget must be carried out within the funds made available and in accordance with the laws governing fiscal responsibility.'
