HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1123, L. D. 1444, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Licensing of Guides Under Fish and Game Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the next to the last underlined  
paragraph (same in L. D.) and inserting in place thereof the  
following underlined paragraph:

'Whenever a guide is convicted of having violated any provisions  
of the inland fish and game laws, or any of the rules and regulation  
established by the commissioner for the licensing of guides, said  
commissioner shall suspend a guide's license for 2 years and shall  
deny the right to hunt or fish for 2 years.'
