COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1130, L. D. 1457, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for Special Plates Observing the State of Maine Sesquicentennial."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

Sec. 1. Authority. The Maine State Sesquicentennial Commission, established under the private and special laws of 1967, chapter 165, is authorized to design, distribute and sell commemorative sesquicentennial simulated motor vehicle registration plates. The commission, in its discretion, may license the design, distribution and sale of such plates. The commission shall promulgate such rules and regulations as it deems appropriate with respect to the design, distribution and sale of commemorative sesquicentennial simulated motor vehicle registration plates. No such plates shall be sold, distributed or displayed which are not approved by the commission.

Sec. 2. Use. Residents of Maine may display one plate on the front of any registered motor vehicle from December 25, 1969 to March 1, 1971. The sesquicentennial plates are not to be used in lieu of regular registration plates, nor are they required to be displayed on a motor vehicle. The regular front registration plate of a motor vehicle may be removed and the sesquicentennial plate displayed in its place. Nonresidents may purchase plates. They may display one plate on the front of a motor vehicle registered in another state while operating in this State.

Sec. 3. Fees. The price of the plates shall be determined by the commission. The funds received by the commission from the sale of such plates or licenses granted for the design, distribution or sale of such plates shall be expended by the commission for the observance of the 150th anniversary of the formation of the State of Maine and for other lawful purposes of the commission.'
