CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1151, L. D. 1473,
Bill, "AN ACT Providing for Presidential Preferences in Primary
Election."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting
clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 21, §441-A, additional. Title 21 of the Revised
Statutes is amended by adding a new section 441-A, to read as follows:
§441-A. Presidential preference in primary

At the primary election voters shall be given an opportunity
to vote for their choice of a candidate for President of the United
States in their respective parties. In order for the name of a
candidate for President to appear upon a party ballot, the state
chairman of each political party shall submit to the Secretary of
State prior to April 15th of the presidential election year a list
of those persons who in the opinion of the state committee are
active candidates for the presidency of their parties. The Secretary
of State shall include those names on the ballot. Voters may write
in the name of a candidate in accordance with section 921, subsection
2.'
