HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1153, L. D. 1475, Bill, "AN ACT to Prevent the Pollution of the Waters of China Lake."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 1 the following paragraph:

'In accordance with the intent of this legislation, to prevent the pollution of the waters of China Lake, and in the furtherance of the desire of all concerned to maintain the value of China Lake as a valuable recreational resource of the State of Maine, and in view of the fact that this legislation forbids trespass on many of the lands bordering the lake, the Kennebec Water District shall make available certain of its shore properties within easy access to Route #32 in East Vassalboro available to the Vassalboro Park and Conservation Commission for development as a boat landing facility and picnic area, with sufficient room for parking, picnic tables and adequate sanitary facilities. Such area is to be developed and maintained by the Vassalboro Park and Conservation Commission or the State Park and Recreation Commission and approved by the Division of Sanitary Engineering, Department of Health and Welfare.'
