HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1155, L.D. 1477, Bill, "AN ACT

Amend said Bill in the 6th line (Same in L.D. 1477) by  
striking out the underlined word "fundamental"

Further amend said Bill in the 12th line (11th line of L.D.)  
by inserting after the underlined word "trapping" the underlined  
words 'by Indians'

Further amend said Bill in the 12th and 13th lines (11th and  
12th lines of L.D.) by striking out the underlined punctuation  
and words ", both as to Indians and all others"
