HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1170, L. D. 1492, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Bag Limit on and Registration of Bears."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the 3rd paragraph of that part designated "§2355-C" of section 3 (same in L. D.) the following new paragraph:

'If any person leaves the woods without taking a bear which he has killed with him he shall notify a warden within 7? hours as to the location of the bear and the circumstances necessitating his leaving the same in the woods.'
