HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1170, L. D. 1492, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Bag Limit on and Registration of Bears."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the 3rd paragraph of that
part designated "§2355-C" of section 3 (same in L. D.) the following
new paragraph:

'If any person leaves the woods without taking a bear which he has
killed with him he shall notify a warden within 72 hours as to the location
of the bear and the circumstances necessitating his leaving the same
in the woods.'
