SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1178, L.D. 1499, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Fee for Breweries and Wholesale Outlets to Sell Malt Liquor."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following;

'R. S., T. 28, §604, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 604 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The fee therefor shall be ~~\$300~~ \$500 per year, which sum shall accompany the application for such certificate.'
